

NO ELECTRONIC DEVICES

Students are not to bring Electronic devices to school. This includes but it not limited to: iPods, Walkmans, radios, beepers, PDA's, CD players, MP3 players, portable video games, PSPs, video cameras, or cameras to school. These devices can be confiscated from students. When electronic devices or cell phones are confiscated, they only will be returned to a parent no earlier than 24 hours later. Cell phones must NOT be ON during the school day (8:30 a.m. to 3:15 p.m.) Cell phones may be picked up from 8:00-8:25am or 3:15-3:45pm only. Cell phones should not be visible during the school day for any reason. Students with more than one violation will not be permitted to have a cell phone on campus. Students and parents sign a cell phone agreement, and all rules are listed.

Electronic Device or Cell phone consequences

1st offense- warning and the item will remain in the Dean's office for one week and must be picked up by a parent. If the parent picks the item up before the week time frame they will sign a letter stating that the next infraction will result in a suspension.

2nd offense-Saturday school, item must remain in the Dean's office for one week, and the parent/guardian will have to schedule a conference with the dean prior to phone pickup.

3rd offense-Suspension

After the third offense it will be up to the school's administration on whether or not the student's privilege to carry the phone on campus will be revoked.

If the student refuses to hand over the device it will be an automatic Out of School suspension.
